International Seed Testing Association (ISTA)

International Seed Testing Association (ISTA) is an inter-governmental organisation established in 1924 at Zurich, Switzerland. ISTA develop, adopt and publish standard procedures for sampling and testing of seeds and provides standards for domestic & international seed trade.

ISTA standards have been adopted across the world including India to ensure the supply of quality seeds to the farming community. Currently, 81 countries around the world are the members of ISTA.

Around the world ISTA has international community of approximately 400 experienced, competent and energetic seed scientists and analysts. ISTA is committed to developing seed standards and promoting uniform application of these standards for domestic and international seed trade.

ISTA works in coordination with the international organisations like FAO, UPOV, OECD, ISF etc.

Mission of ISTA is to work together to achieve 'Uniformity in seed quality testing worldwide' by:

- Internationally agreed rules for seed sampling and testing;
- Accreditation of seed testing laboratories;
- Promotion of Seed Science Research;
- Provides trainings and disseminates knowledge in seed science and technology
- Facilitate seed trade at nationally and internationally and also contributes to global food security.

ISTA is managed and directed by a nine members Executive Governing Board, who are the representatives of the government from different countries across the World.



ISTA conducts Seed Congress once in 3 years to provide a global platform for exchange of knowledge in seed related aspects by involving world renowned stake holders from public and private seed industry. ISTA Seed Congress has been conducted in Europe, America, New Zealand and Australia.

The 32nd edition of ISTA Seed Congress was held in Hyderabad, Telangana State, India for the first time in Asia.

He also commended the role of ISTA and thanked the Government of Telangana for organising the ISTA Seed Congress as a global event that would help to strengthen the Indian seed sector.

Shri S. 670 delegates from around 75 countries including policy makers, scientists, researchers, representatives of international organisations like International Seed Testing Association (ISTA), Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD), International Union for Protection of Plant Varieties (UPOV), Food and Agriculture Organisation (FAO), International Seed Federation (ISF), Asia-Pacific Seed Association (APSA) and other regional seed associations were participated.

The ISTA Seed Congress provided a platform for all the delegates, the opportunity of global interaction, network building and the deliberations were made on the several issues related to Seed production and quality under the theme “Seed Technology and Quality in a Changing World” in five different sessions.

The Indian seed industry in general and Telangana Seed Industry in particular has benefitted much from this congress, in terms of updating the knowledge, skills and understanding of the recent advances in seed production, testing and seed science research, that in turn leads to improvement in the seed production and quality seed supply system in the State as well as country.

The election of the Governing Board of ISTA for the year 2019-22 was held as per the constitution of ISTA during the 32nd ISTA Seed Congress on July 02, 2019 with voting franchise exercised by the government representatives from different countries across the World.

Dr. K. Keshavulu, Director and Managing Director, Telangana State Seed and Organic Certification Authority and Seeds Development Corporation, Hyderabad has been elected as Vice-President of ISTA for the year 2019-22 and he will be taking over the presidentship of ISTA as per the norms of ISTA for the year 2022-25 in the 33rd ISTA Seed Congress.

Dr. Keshavulu is the first ever person from Asian Continent to become the Vice-President/ President of the prestigious International body on Seed Testing in its 95 years of History.

It is a great opportunity for contribution towards development of Indian Seed Industry in general and Telangana seed sector in particular by improving the share in international seed market, improving the efficiency of seed certification agencies and seeds corporations, accreditation of seed testing labs, and improves global networking of seed companies through OECD, UPOV, FAO, ISF and SAARC in seed production, quality control and marketing globally. Further scope to accomplish the actions required for sustainable and globally competitive seed sector in the country as well as state.

ISTA Workshop on "Seed Morphology and Seed Identification for Purity, and OSD Test (June 22-24, 2019)





Twenty three (23) participants from 7 countries – Bangladesh (3), Ethiopia (2), India (8), Iraq (5), Malaysia (1), Philippines (1), Tanzania (2) and Uganda (2) – attended the workshop. They were from governmental seed testing stations and the seed industry.

The workshop provided an overview of seed sampling, purity, germination analysis as well as testing of seed moisture content of a range of species, and also provided a forum where questions relating to seed sampling and testing methodologies were discussed.
